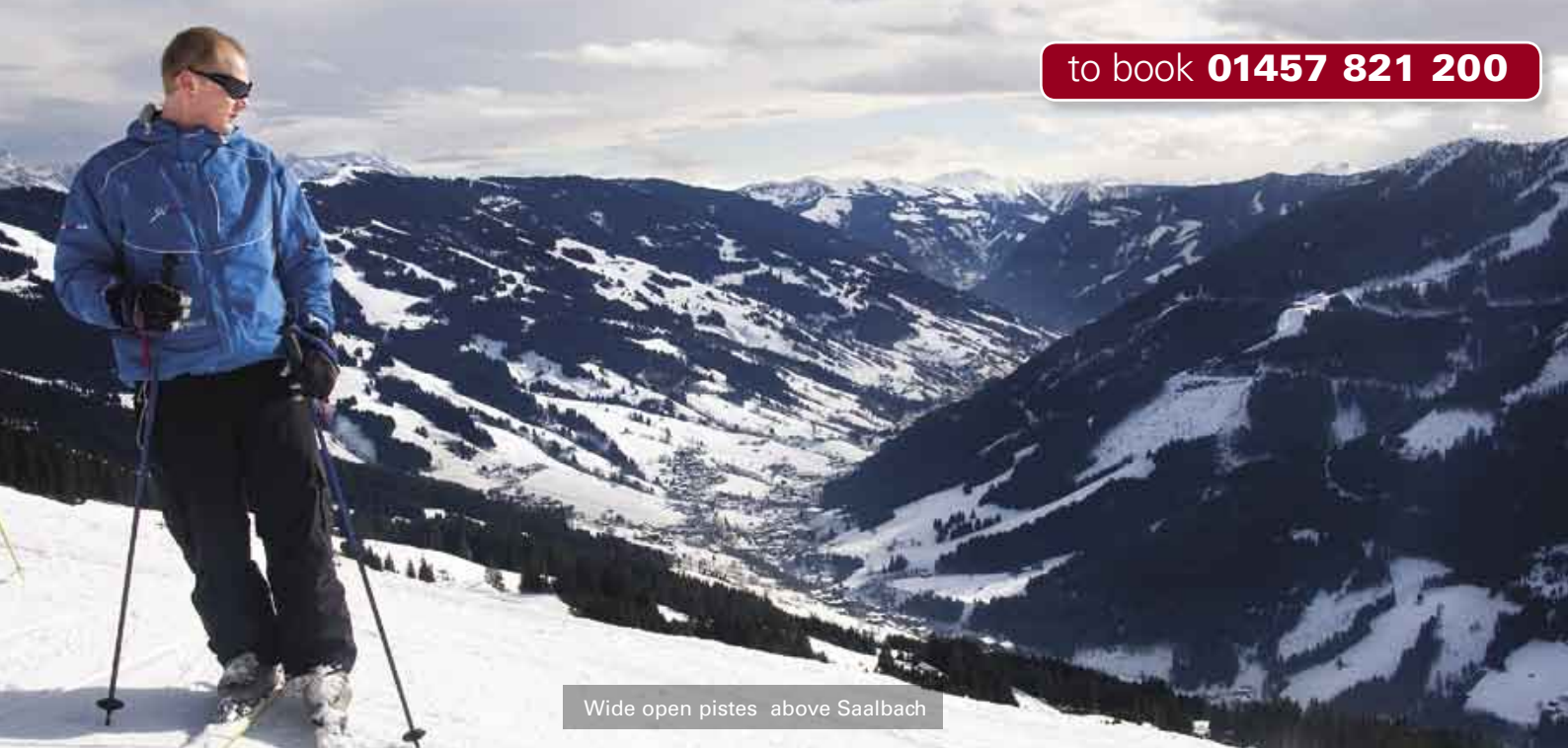


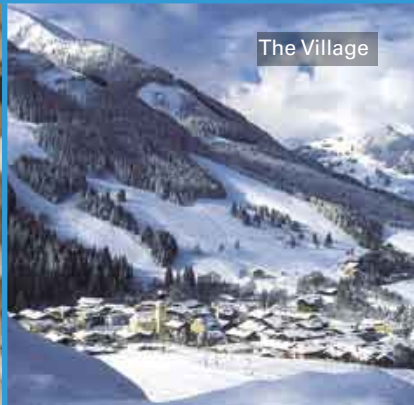

**Saalbach is known as the Ski Circus** and is credited with having the best skiing outside the Arlberg region - the integrated 200 kms of skiing, snow record and formidable cannon justify this claim.

**The valley sides face north and south so** start in the sun and move to the other side as the day warms. For advanced skiers the north slopes hold powder very well, a local guide will find you the best off piste options.

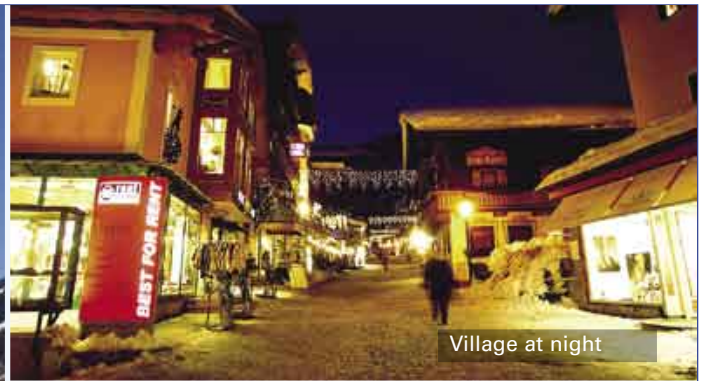

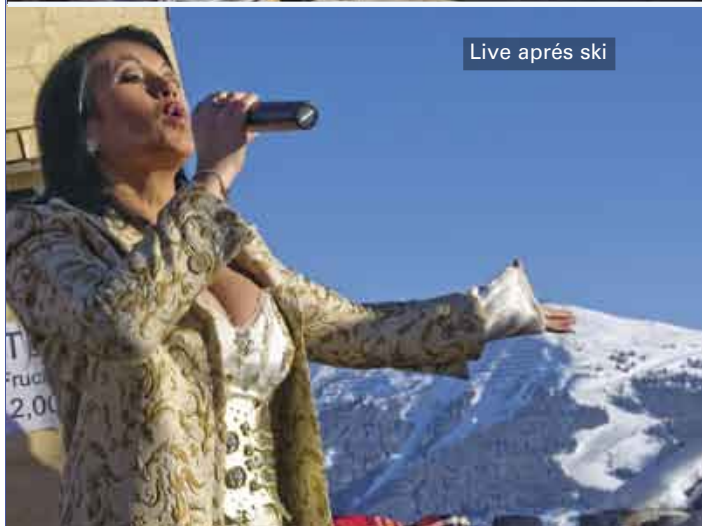

### About the valley and the village

The Glemmtal is a gentle sided valley in the Pinzgau region, the main nearby town is Zell am See, about twenty kilometers away towards the Kaprun glacier. The area was first settled in the thirteenth century so has had plenty of time to smooth its alpine pastures for skiing. The classic onion-domed church, Hotel Post and the old jail (now a night club) remind the visitor of the pre skiing days. The valley made its name in the ski world by hosting many major competitions in the nineties. The valley is a cul-de-sac and is not affected by through traffic.

### Après Ski

It is good not to be surrounded by bland apartment blocks, traditional local architecture has been maintained. There is a wide choice of restaurants available for the staff night off. You can choose to eat on the mountain and toboggan

back, or eat at La Trattoria to have a change from the local food that is extensively available at excellent prices on the mountain. Shopping is reasonable in the village but Hinterglemm has a better selection however Saalbach wins for après ski and nightlife - try the Jail!

### Après Ski on the mountain

The area has fifty-two mountain huts serving excellent well priced food and drinks. Guests who have only skied in France were pleasantly surprised by the reasonable prices. We have yet to find poor quality or bad service!

A big bonus is the famous Saalbach happy hour, much appreciated by our guests. Two drinks for the price of one are served in the hour before 4:30 pm. It is a good plan not to have too far to ski afterwards, there is a big choice. We will take you to our favourites when you come with Ski Miquel to Saalbach.



## Chalet-Hotel Christina

Acquired last year by Ski Miquel and extensively renovated to the company's highest standards. The location is ideal - easy access to the lifts and village with its many shops, bars and clubs yet undisturbed by Saalbach's famed energetic night life. This house is an important addition to the programme as there is now a Ski Miquel chalet-hotel in this major resort offering holidays at previously unseen value. Guests last winter frequently commented on the excellent size and quality of the bedrooms. The separate lounge with comfortable sofas for all guests is an alternative to the

stubl for a relaxing evening. There is a small bar which will serve well-priced draught beer and a good selection of spirits and local schnapps. The stubl area can be used after dinner to play board or card games. A top spec hi-fi gives excellent musical entertainment, either providing a gentle relaxing mood or a more upbeat night, you decide. Canapés are served before dinner, which includes complimentary wine. Dinner is from the Ski Miquel menu, ensuring excellent cuisine. A buffet breakfast and traditional after-ski tea are included.
